In 2023 we celebrated the 25th anniversary of our Learning Program. There are 1,200 children in our Learning Program on any given week, and each year this important Program prevents 45 children from repeating a year at school and 41 from dropping out of school, due to the impact of a serious illness or injury on their education.
